ABIDE. A Jesus follower abides in Christ personally and daily.

CONNECT. A Jesus follower connects in community in large group and small group.

SHARE. A Jesus follower shares in the mission locally and globally.

The life of a Jesus follower is all about relationships! So how do you deepen these three relationships and grow as a follower of Jesus? Answer: The same way you deepen any relationship—TIME. In 2016, we introduced four strategic ways we can invest our time and grow as Jesus followers.










In March of 2016, over **1500 people** expressed their desire to grow as Jesus followers by accepting the **5% Life Challenge**.

WHAT IS THE 5% LIFE?

1% of your day (15 min) in God time daily.
1% of your week (1.5 hrs) in Gather time weekly
1% of your month (7 hrs) in Group time consistently
2% of your year (7 days) in Go time annually

We are convinced that if you embrace "The 5% Life" as a starting point, the other 95% of your life will be changed forever as you abide in Christ, connect in community, and share in the mission.



CHANDLER'S STORY

Chandler Deleon was living the typical Las Vegas teenager life. Growing up in Catholic schools, she had friends, her family had money, and she had everything a teenager needs - but her life was missing something. She grew up vaguely hearing about bits and pieces of the Bible but never understanding what it meant to have a love relationship with Jesus. She did, however, have a lifelong friend named Cheyenne who would be the door that God would use to invite Chandler to a life with Jesus. After Cheyenne began following Jesus, she became burdened for where her friend Chandler was going to spend eternity. One day, she invited Chandler to come to a worship service at Hope Church.

"After I blew Cheyenne off over and over about going to church, I finally was at a place in my life where I thought I'd give it a try even though I didn't really want anything to do with God." The good news for Chandler is that although she didn't want anything to do with God, He wanted everything to do with her.



In the summer of 2012, Chandler walked into Hope Church for the first time. "I was a bit overwhelmed, but it was completely different than anything I'd ever experienced, and I liked it. I continued to attend, and I met a lot of people that I really liked. Honestly, I fell in love with Hope before I fell in love with Jesus. From the first moment I walked into Hope I felt like I was a part of the family, and since I come from a broken family, that is not something I was familiar with. God surrounded me with people to love me and to help me through some of the hardest days of my life."

"One of the messages I heard at Hope was about how you can't just believe God exists in your head, you have to put your faith in Him and trust Him with all your heart." Chandler said. "I realized that I had knowledge about God in my head, but my heart and life had not been transformed."

After hearing the gospel clearly at Hope, Chandler Deleon became a Jesus follower. She recalls that as a new Christian, in community at Hope, she was discipled, encouraged, and cared for by people who loved her and walked with her on her journey. God used the people of Hope Church to help Chandler discover that the life of a Jesus follower is all about relationships. In 2016, Hope Church was privileged to send Chandler out for the summer to serve as a mid-term missionary in South America where she shared with others about her abiding relationship with God that has changed her life.



THE CORDLES' STORY

In 2014 Hope Church was in the process of sending Pastor Josh Carter and his family to Portland, Oregon to plant Remedy City Church. Upon hearing about Remedy City, Mitzie became interested in being a part of this new church. After visiting Portland on a mission trip with a team sent by Hope in 2015, God placed a burden on her heart for the city of Portland, and her desire was that her husband Robert would feel the same. Unfortunately, at that time, that was not the case.



However, in the summer of 2015, Robert gave his life to Jesus and his heart was then softened to the things of God. This radically changed the Cordle family. Robert and Mitzie immediately placed their yes on the table with a desire for their family to be used by God. They began to pray for God to make it clear to them if Portland was where He wanted them. In September of 2016, Robert and Mitzie went to Portland together on a mission team that was sent by Hope Church, and it was during that trip that He confirmed their calling to that city to be a part of Remedy City Church. In December of 2016, Robert, Mitzie, Dawson, and Lily moved to Portland, commissioned by Hope Church to be missionaries in the city of Portland, Oregon.


When God birthed our church, He had the nations on His heart! In 2016, we worked on 6 continents to connect people to live the life of a Jesus follower!

LOST, SAVED, AND SENT

On May 30th, 2002, Zeke Tomaselli graduated from Hilo High School. The very next day he left the island of Hawaii and moved to Las Vegas. He had been in trouble, losing scholarships to college, and needed a fresh start. He had an older sister living in Vegas already, and his mom sent him to live with her. When Zeke arrived at the airport, his sister met him, and the first thing she wanted to do was take him to meet her pastor. Out of respect for his sister, he agreed. That was a day that ended up changing his life!

That day Zeke met Pastor Vance and the rest of the staff at Hope. They began investing in him and discipling him, and it was through their influence that Zeke came to know Christ. As Zeke began to grow in this relationship with God, God called him into ministry. Zeke served at Hope in many areas from youth to worship arts. Being able to serve in these ministries allowed him to grow in the calling God has placed on his life. Part of this growth was God giving him a passion for the people of Hawaii. He knew that one day God would bring him back to his home state to minister to the people there.

It was also through Hope where Zeke and his wife Layne met and were married. Both had a calling and passion for missions and knew God was going to use that greatly in their lives. In 2009, as God continued to grow their hearts for Hawaii, they ended up moving farther away from Zeke's home state. They were planning to move to Virginia where Zeke could finish his schooling but ended up staying in Tennessee with Layne's family while her father had cancer treatment. During this time God healed her father and brought new connections into their lives for Zeke and Layne to serve in a small church in rural Tennessee.

As they served at this Church, God began to grow within them the calling to Hawaii and more clearly define what that would look like. Through a church planting focus by the North American Mission Board, God showed the Tomasellis that He was calling them to plant a church in Hawaii. After much prayer, counsel, and evaluation, the couple moved back to Vegas to take part in church planter training. Zeke was back on staff at Hope, this time as a Church Planting Apprentice. God used this time to grow and develop Zeke and define the calling of what it would look like to plant a church in Zeke's hometown of Hilo, Hawaii. This was the beginning of Ohana Church.

After a year of training it was time to move to the field! Hope sent this couple out with much support. As they arrived in Hilo, God began to open up doors to build relationships with many of Zeke's friends who were still living in Hilo, most of which had no relationship with God! In fact, that first weekend the Tomasellis were in Hilo, these friends threw a party for them at the beach,



another let them live in his home until they could find a house, and many more helped them move once their belongings arrived. God was opening up the doors wide to build relationships and share the Gospel!

Ohana Church officially launched on April 20th, 2014. Since then many have come to know Christ, and three more churches have been started with plans for two more! Ohana Church now has about 60 people gathering each week for worship and 25 connected in Community Groups on a regular basis! God continues to move in great ways in Hawaii. When Ohana Church began, one of the biggest issues they faced was many people being without jobs, but God is providing jobs for them. Families are being restored, and lives are being changed. The church has been able to connect with the Hilo High Football team, where Zeke is a running backs coach, and serve the players, coaches, and their families. This is the third year the church has partnered with the football team, and this year many of the players and managers were able to be part of Youth Camp! God continues to give connection within the community and open doors to take the Gospel throughout Hawaii, the Pacific, and the world.

We know that when God plants a church, it is never just about the church but the city and the people of that city. One of the ways the Tomasellis have personally seen this lived out has been through the adoption of their two, soon to be three, sons. When God brought this family to Hilo, He also had these three boys on His heart! This is an amazing picture of God's redemption in the lives of His children! This process has also revealed the heart of Ohana Church Family. Because of the investment of Hope Church, Ohana Church is able to love people to the beauty of Christ!
